<u>Cashless Payments 18/19:</u> if you are unable to set up online payments for September, you will need to request Paypoint Vouchers for your child/children for Dinners, Trips etc from Sept '18. If you request these before the end of this term we will have your Paypoint Vouchers ready for collection during the first week of the Autumn Term. You will need to come to the school office to sign for them. If you require more than one set of vouchers i.e. for your child's other guardian, please ensure that you requests them in plenty of time for us to be able to get them ready for collection.

Note: When using the vouchers please ensure that you use the right one for the type of payment you are making, there will be one voucher for each payment category i.e. school dinners, trips/events, milk etc. The payment category will be clearly stated on each voucher.

<u>VERY IMPORTANT</u> – Seely is a *NUT FREE* school. This includes Nutella spread. Please do not send your child with Nutella filled sandwiches. If you do the sandwich will be disposed of and your child will be supplied with a school sandwich with fruit, for which you will be charged £2.05.
