<u>Parents Meeting about Year 4 Residential:</u> There will be a meeting to discuss the Year 4 Residential trip arrangements on 8th March, 3.45 in KS2 Hall. If your child is going on residential please do try to attend as important information will be discussed.

Attendance Advice / Info: Though we have a significant number of children whose attendance has remained very high since September, attendance overall is less good, at only 95 %. Some absences are unavoidable: if absence is forced by illness such as physical sickness or something more substantial/long-lasting, please contact school as early as possible on the first day and on each subsequent each day of absence, so class teachers may be alerted as soon as possible.. Other good practices include:

- Avoid taking your child out of school (even for short periods of time) for non-urgent medical or dental appointments;
- Remember to bring evidence such as reminder text message, referral letter or appointment card for school-time medical appointments; and
- Don't let an ordinary cold (including symptoms such as runny nose and slightly raised temperature) keep your child away from school – we will always contact parents/ carers if a child is too ill to be in school.

Taking opportunities to improve attendance will benefit the whole school community.
