Dear Parents and Carers,

I have recently received the resignation of vice chair to the governing body, Naomi Fearon. As well as being a governor she chaired the governing body for several years, including through the merger of the two schools. On behalf of staff and governors, I would like to thank Naomi for her many contributions to the development of Seely School and wish her well.

This, along with some other terms ending, means we have some parent governor vacancies on the governing body, and we would like you to start thinking about how you can contribute. There will be an election in the autumn term when we return. To prepare for this I thought it might be useful to provide a bit of background to the role and expectations of it:

- · The role of the governing body is a strategic one; more details can be found here: http://www.nga.org.uk/Be-a-Governor/Be-a-Governor.aspx
- The opportunity to represent / present the perspective and thoughts of parents in governance conversations
- · The opportunity to be a link governor and support an area of school work and development.
- Experience of governing bodies or education is not required, this role is open to all parents and carers, training and a buddying system is provided
- · Training and support will be given by governors and the Local Authority Governors Service
- · The time commitment is 3 FGB meetings a year (2 hours each, commence at 6.15pm), 3 sub committees per year (1 to 2 hours each, commence 4 or 5pm), 2 or 3 hours per month of link work, one off meetings, reading and email responses. This equates to about 8 hours per month, in term times only.
- Future dates for FGB 2017/18 are currently set as: Tues 14th Nov 17 and Tues 20th March 18.

With the next formal meeting in November, we propose to take expressions of interest and nominations and conduct an election at the start of next term. This is a really important role to complete the balance of the board. If you have any questions that aren't addressed in this letter please contact either myself or the head teachers.

If you want to contribute to the development of the school, but governance does not appeal, you can also join Friends of Seely, which is making an increasing and meaningful impact on the school calendar.
