GENERAL INFORMATION

Paperless News: A quick reminder that this will be the last printed newsletter going out automatically to all families. From Sept the newsletter will be, as it currently is, available on the school website and through the "Seely Primary" app (available to download free from the play and app stores). You can also sign up through the school website for the newsletters to be emailed directly to you. If you require a printed copy of the newsletter for your family please ask at school reception.

Cashless Payments: in addition to our existing online payment facility and in our strive to become an almost cashless school; we will shortly be trialling a "paypoint" payment option. There are multiple pay points in the local Sherwood area and more details about this will following the new academic year. If you are interested in trialling "paypoint" payments, or want to discuss the online payments facility, please speak to the staff at school reception. **Contact Details:** In preparation for the new academic year and to ensure that new class

teachers have correct details; please can you make sure that any changes of details (address, phone numbers etc) are communicated to the office staff using the change of details forms provided at reception as soon as possible.

Dinner & Milk Money from September 2017:

- Nursery children meals will increase to £1.95 each
- Year 3 to Year 6 meals will increase to £2.05 each (£10.25 per week)
- Foundation 2 and Years 1 and 2 school meals are currently free under the Government Universal Free School meals initiative.
- The cost for Milk <u>will not be increasing</u>, remaining at £10.00 per term or a sliding scale for children in Foundation 2

Parents claiming certain benefits may be able to apply for Free Meals from Pupil Benefits, Nottingham City Council. Application forms for this are available from the office. Please be reminded that all school dinners must be paid for in advance. We are implementing a new debt recovery system from September so if you are having difficulty making payments please make an appointment to discuss this with one of the Head teachers.
