Please ensure that you **pay for meals in advance**. If you receive certain benefits you may be able to claim for Free School Meals. Please collect an application form from the office. You will need to provide evidence of any benefits you are claiming with your application. If you are entitled, an authority is usually granted within 24 hours and a letter will be sent to you.

If you change your child's meal pattern please ensure that you inform the office straight away to avoid charges.

Please also be advised, as per the letter that was sent out this week, any child not on a school meal pattern, who turns up to school without a packed lunch, and the office are not notified, will only now receive a school packed lunch, <u>not</u> a hot dinner; they will no longer be provided with a school meal and will be charged for the packed lunch they received.

<u>School Photograph Orders</u>: You can still bring orders with payments into school as we have not yet reached the minimum order number, please be advised that these will not be collected now until after the Easter Holidays.

<u>School Communication:</u> Please download the FREE "SEELY" app via the playstore or the app store to ensure that you don't miss out on any notifications. Search for "seely" and it should be displayed. Ask for Mrs Gallagher-Read at reception if you have difficulties with the app and she will be happy to help.
