Lunch Option Changes: This last week we have had several children change from packed lunches to school meals, vice versa or to School Sandwich's. Please be reminded that the kitchen require ONE WEEK'S notice for ordering purposes so that there is enough food to cover requirements and as little food as possible is wasted.

Dinner Money Owing: In future if your dinner debt is over £20.50 for Year 3 to 6 or £18.50 for Nursery children and you have not made a payment plan arrangement with a Headteacher, your child must bring a packed lunch as we will no longer be able to provide a cooked meal for them.

School App: Apple have changed some of their app rules so unfortunately the current school app will become inactive after the 1st June. To download the replacement app please follow the following simple instructions:

To download, search for "School Jotter" in the app store / play store and then search and select our school from within the app. Once the school has been selected by the user, the app will adapt to then match the branding and theme of your current school app. *All of our parents who have been using the current app can do so until the end of May 2018.*

If you don't download the new app, you will receive a notification that your app will soon be out of date. In the links section, you will be provided a transfer guide and links to the apps in the App Store and Google Play Store.

Starting 1st June 2018, your current app will be blocked and you will be directed to download and use the new School Jotter app.

Everything will stay in place - logos, design, content, etc, the only difference is that you need to download the new School Jotter app and select Seely school from the list. If you haven't already downloaded the app please do so as from Sept the bulk of school messaging will be delivered via this method. This will save us a lot of money on texting and I'm sure you appreciate we need to make savings where we can. *Mrs Gallagher-Read will be happy to help if you are having problems - ask for her at reception.*

<u>Seely is going CASHLESS</u>: Please be reminded that from September we will be a cashless school (cheques will also no longer be accepted). Please ask at the school office about options for September.
